RE: HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND GRANT FOR STUDENTS

Dear AAC Students:

I am reaching out to all of you to let you know that AAC continues to work hard to bring you your program education via our approval of our Temporary Distance Education. During these unprecedented times, AAC will continue to keep the school actively working with all students for the continuation of their education.

AAC's goal is to ensure the health and safety of our students and employees and we are monitoring the State of Florida's plan for re-opening. As we do this, AAC has also been applying for additional funding for our currently enrolled students through the Department of Education's – Emergency Financial Aid Grants.

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Grant for Students was applied for by AAC and has been approved for these funds. This funding will go to our students whom qualify. AAC will be implementing the policy for students to apply for emergency relief funds and will be disbursing these funds.

The **emergency** funds will require a form to be completed and signed for AAC to determine eligibility and amount of funding to each student.

These funds are for **students actively enrolled and in good standing** at AAC on or by **March 16, 2020** and who have filled out the funding form, signed it and are qualified (see below). **Anyone on a leave of absence will not qualify for this funding.**

- Students must be Title IV eligible to receive these grants:
 - Currently enrolled students actively participating in Title IV
 - Current enrolled students who have filled out FAFSA forms and have a clear ISIR
